Sew the blocks into rows, pressing each row in the opposite direction. Sew the rows together, press
Sew the $1^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF Olive Tonal strips together end to end to make one long strip. Sew this strip to the right side of the quilt, press and trim excess. Repeat on leff, top and bottom.

3. Repeat step 2 using the $6^{1 / 2 " x}$ WOF Olive Trees strips.
4. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.

## Block 1 (Large Leaf) $12^{1 / 2 / 2}$ square

1. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong
side of six $4^{1 / 2}$ "Lt Khaki Dots squares. Place one of these squares on top of a $41 / 2$ " Gold Tonal square and sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to within $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " of the seam and press open. Repeat to make six half-triangle squares.

2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of twelve $41 / 2 \mathrm{Lt}$ Khaki Dots squares. Place one of these squares on one end of a $41 / 2 \mathrm{x} \times 81 / 2$ " Olive Leaves rectangle watching placement and sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance within $1 / 4$ " of the seam and press open. Repeat to make six. Repeat this step again using the $411 /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{11 / 2}$ "Brown Dots rectangles in place of the Olive Leaves, make six.

3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of six $41 / 2$ " Lt Khaki Dots squares. Place one of these squares on one end of a $41 /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{1 / 2}$ " Brown Seeded Twig rectangle. Be sure to watch placement of the square as the angle is reversed on this section.
Sew on the drawn line, trim seam allowance and press open. Repeat to make six.

4. Draw a diagonal line on the
wrong side of the $31 / 2$ " Lt Khaki Dots squares. Place one of these squares on the top left corner of a $41 / 2$ " Olive Tonal square. Sew on the drawn line, trim seam allowance and press open. Repeat on the opposite (lower right) corner of the same square. Repeat to make six stem units.
5. Layout the pieces from step 1-4 and a $41 /{ }^{1 / 2}$ Lt Khaki Dots square as shown and sew together to complete the block. Make six large leaf blocks. Block 2 (Small Leaves) $\mathbf{6}^{1 / 2}$ " square


1. Referring to Diagram 1, draw a
diagonal line on the wrong side of twenty-one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Lt Khaki Dots squares and place one on top of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Gold Tonal square. Sew on the drawn line, trim seam allowance and press open. Repeat to make twentyone half-triangle squares.

2. Referring to Diagram 2, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of forty-two $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Lt Khaki Dots squares. Place one of these squares on one end of a $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime x} 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Gold Dots rectangle watching placement and sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance and press open. Repeat to make twenty-one. Repeat this step again using the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{11 / 2}$ " Brown Dots rectangles in place of the Gold Dots, make twenty-one.
3. Referring to Diagram 3, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of twenty-one $21 / 2 " L t$ Khaki Dots squares. Place one of these squares on one end of a $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 41 / 2 "$ Brown Seeded Twig rectangle. Be sure to watch placement of the square as the angle is reversed on this section. Sew on the drawn line, trim seam allowance and press open. Repeat to make twenty-one.
4. Referring to Diagram 4, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2" Lt Khaki Dots squares. Place one of these squares on the top left corner of a $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Olive Tonal square. Sew on the drawn line, trim seam allowance and press open. Repeat on the opposite (lower right) corner of the same square. Repeat to make twenty-one stem units.
5. Layout the pieces from step $1-4$ and a $2^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Lt Khaki Dots square as you did for the large leaf to complete the small leaf blocks. Refer to diagram 5 if needed. Make twenty-one.
6. Referring to the diagram below, layout three small leaf blocks and a $61 / 2$ "Lt Khaki Dots square, rotating the leaves as necessary. Sew them together to make an A block. Repeat to make five A blocks.
7. Referring to the diagram below, layout two small leaf blocks and a $61 / 2$ "Lt Khaki Dots square and a $61 / 2$ " Cream Tonal square. Sew them together to make a B block. Repeat to make three B blocks.
8. Repeat steps $1-5$ above to make five more small leaf blocks this time using the Cream Tonal squares in place of the Lt Khaki Dots squares.
9. Using three squares from step 8 and a $61 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Cream Tonal square sew the units together to make one $C$ block.
10. Using one block from step 8, a $61 / 2$ " Cream Tonal square and a $6^{1 / 2}$ " $\times 12^{1 / 2}$ " Cream Tonal rectangle, sew together as shown to make one D block. Repeat this step turning the leaf to make one E block.

## Putting It Together

1. Referring to the diagram below, layout the blocks and $121 / 2$ " Cream Tonal squares into five rows of four blocks each, rotating the blocks as needed.
