



Block 10 15½" x 18½" unfinished

Cutting

Tree 1–6½" x 3½" rectangle 4–6½" x 2" rectangles	House Roof 1–8" x 4½" rectangle	Bird Appliqué 1–beak 1–body	Background 1–8" x 2¾" rectangle 1–8" x 2" rectangle
Tree Trunk 1–1½" x 6½" rectangle	House 2–8" x 2" rectangles 4–4" x 2½" rectangles	1–tail 1–wing 1–eye	1–6½" x 3½" rectangle 2–4¼" squares 2–3½" squares
Star 1–4" square 8–2½" squares	4–2½" squares		$2-3$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles $1-2$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle $8-2$ squares



Block 10 is 15" x 18" finished.




Construction

Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

1 Tree


(A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–3½" background squares. Layer a 3½" marked background square, right sides together, on 1–6½" x 3½" tree rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 1.




Tree Top 6½" x 3½" unfinished

(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8–2" background squares. Layer a 2" marked background square, right sides to together, on both ends of a 1–6½" x 2" tree rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal lines. Trim ¼" from the sewn lines. Press to reveal the triangles. Make 4.




(C) Assemble the tree as shown.





7 House

(A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–4½" background squares. Layer a 4½" marked background square, right sides together, on 1–8" x 4½" roof rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ½" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 1.




(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8–2½" star point squares. Layer 2½" marked star point square, right sides together, on 1–4" x 2½" house rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ½" from the sewn line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle. Make 4 star points.




Note: Star Points float more than a 1/4" from the edges.


Star Points 4" x 2½" unfinished Make 4.


(C) Assemble the star as shown.
